



Directions to Lenhardt Rodgers Architecture + Interiors

438 South Bethlehem Pike
Fort Washington, PA 19034

From Allentown:

- I-476 S toward I-276 E/Philadelphia/Exits 44-20
- Merge onto I-276 E/Pennsylvania Turnpike toward New Jersey
- Take the PA 309 exit, EXIT 339, toward Fort Washington/Philadelphia/Ambler
- Stay to the left after tolls
- Road becomes Pennsylvania Ave.
- Turn left onto S. Bethlehem Pike
- Turn right onto first street just over Bridge, our building will be on your right
- Entrance to Lenhardt Rodgers Architects is on the Bethlehem Pike side of the building.

From Philadelphia:

- Take I-76 W
- Merge onto I-476 N via Exit 331B toward Plymouth Meeting
- Merge onto I-276 E/Pennsylvania Turnpike via Exit 20 toward New Jersey
- Take the PA-309 exit, Exit 339, toward Fort Washington/Philadelphia/Ambler
- Stay to the left after tolls
- Road becomes Pennsylvania Ave.
- Turn left onto S. Bethlehem Pike
- Turn right onto first street just over Bridge, our building will be on your right
- Entrance to Lenhardt Rodgers Architects is on the Bethlehem Pike side of the building.

From New Hope:

- Take US-202 S
- US -202 S becomes York Rd./PA-263
- Turn right onto Edison Furlong Rd.
- Turn left onto S. Easton Rd./PA-611
- Merge onto I-276 W/Pennsylvania Turnpike toward Harrisburg
- Take the PA-309 exit, EXIT 339, toward Fort Washington/Philadelphia/Ambler
- Stay to the left after tolls
- Road becomes Pennsylvania Ave.
- Turn left onto S. Bethlehem Pike
- Turn right onto first street just over Bridge, our building will be on your right
- Entrance to Lenhardt Rodgers Architects is on the Bethlehem Pike side of the building.

From the PA Turnpike, heading either East or West

- Take the PA-309 exit, EXIT 339, toward Fort Washington/Philadelphia/Ambler
- Stay to the left after tolls
- Road becomes Pennsylvania Ave.
- Turn left onto S. Bethlehem Pike
- Turn right onto first street just over Bridge, our building will be on your right
- Entrance to Lenhardt Rodgers Architects is on the Bethlehem Pike side of the building.

Public Transportation:

Lenhardt Rodgers Architects is easily accessible by taking SEPTA's regional rail Lansdale/Doylestown line to Ft. Washington train station. Upon exiting train walk to your left straight up to South Bethlehem Pike, make a left and our building is just over the Septa railroad bridge on the right. Septa's bus route 94 also stops nearby.
